2010 National Jamboree Youth Registration Instructions

1. Visit <http://www.bsajamboree.org/> to read about the 2010 National Scout Jamboree.
2. Find your BSA Member ID on your membership card, or contact your unit leader. If necessary, the council office can look up this information; call them at (978) 372-0591.
3. Apply online by visiting www.MyScouting.org with your parent/guardian.
 - a. Log into your MyScouting account, if your parent has one, or create a new account.
 - b. Look for “Event Registrations” link; click it;
 - c. Look for the “Jamboree” link; click it;
 - d. Look for the “2010 National Scout Jamboree Youth Participant Application” link; click it;
 - e. Fill in the required information;
 - f. A \$10 service fee, payable by credit card, is required at application time.
 - g. Print out the reservation confirmation page, and mail it, with a \$100 deposit, payable to Yankee Clipper Council, to reserve your spot.
4. Submit your first installment payment of \$100 on or before January 16, 2009. This installment payment is in addition to the \$100 deposit. **A total of \$200 must be received on or before January 16, 2009 to secure your spot on this adventure!**
5. Please be aware that jamboree preparation includes several troop meetings prior to the actual event. These meetings are active planning and training sessions! Your input and participation assures that this trip is well-planned and fully staffed with trained youth members.
