Individual boy deposits DUE April 4!

In order to qualify for the fee of \$275 or \$230 Patrol cooking, each boy must pay a \$50 deposit by April 4th. The balance must be paid by June 6th. Camp registrations that do not meet these deadline requirements will be \$300 and \$255 respectively.

Enclosed is a Scout camp payment form for your use, submit this form to one of the Council Service Centers with \$50 per boy by April 4th. To properly maintain camp records the name of an individual boy must be listed for each \$50 deposit. If necessary, you may submit a "John Doe" registration, but please remember that deposits are transferable but not refundable.

What about Webelos?

Webelos graduating into your Troop this spring may register for camp at any time and will not be charged a late fee. Please note if a boy is a graduating Webelos when payment is made.

Camperships

A campership application is enclosed. Please make copies as needed for boys in your Troop. Remember funds are limited and applications must be received on or before MAY 1st. Applications must be completely filled out or they may be rejected.

Directions

St. Agnes Church - From Route 114 turn at Angelica's Restaurant onto Route 62, this is Boston Rd. Proceed about ¼ mile church is on your left.

Trinity Lutheran Church - Get to Route 3 heading north via I-495 or Rt. 128. From Rt. 3 take exit 32 (Rt.4) this is the former Drum Hill Rotary which has been squared off with lights added. Follow the signs for Old Westford Rd., approximately 1 mile, left just past Grandview Rd., the Church is set back and not visible from the road.
