The Lone Tree District Activities Committee proudly presents a terrific opportunity for Cub Scouts and Boy Scouts to build and launch their own model rocket. This is a family-oriented event and we encourage each Scout to bring along the rest of his family. **Each family member can also participate** by building and launching his or her own rocket, even if they are not enrolled in Scouting. There is no age limit, so any person who wants to participate may do so.

Updating last year's event, Cub Scouts and their families will be able to launch rockets **MULTIPLE TIMES**. Unlike past events, Scouts siblings and parents are encouraged to bring their own rockets. There is no need to purchase a rocket for the event, unless your son does not already have one. Plan on bringing any rocket(s) to the event, and bring as many engines as you want. We will be launching rockets on a first come, first serve basis. Each Scout, child and or parent can launch his/her rocket and simply get back into line. Our CMASS inspection crew will be on site to make sure all rockets are safe to launch.

Rockets can be purchased at any hobby store or online. I strongly suggest using Pratt's Hobby Store in Georgetown, as Peter Pratt has over 30 years of rocket experience. Rockets will be inspected by CMASS before each launch. Any rocket deemed unsafe will not be allowed to launch. A table will be available to fix rockets that do not pass inspection or were damaged during flight.

Note: The launch site preparation and launch pad positioning will be performed by CMASS. We will be looking for Boy Scout and adult volunteers to help administer the event, but they will not be directly involved with the launch. All Scouts in attendance will receive a commemorative patch. Please make sure that all Scouts and Adult Volunteers in attendance are wearing their best Class "A" uniforms.

Peter Pratt will have a tent full of Rocket related items for sale. There will also be a cash grill offering hamburgers, hot dogs and soft drinks for sale. Packs and Troops are encouraged to eat with their families, but pay close attention to the launch pad. If you decide to bring food on your own, please leave nut related items at home.

Registration **AND** payment are due to the Haverhill Scout Office by June 14<sup>th</sup>.

The Yankee Clipper Council wants to remind all involved in this event to practice proper Scouting. The buddy system will be in effect all day for all Scout participants. Children should be encouraged to perform as much of the labor building the rockets as possible. If Scouting principles are followed, the event will be safe, exciting and informative for all involved.
