## Powderhorn Goals

- Knowledge of how to identify local resources and consultants for high adventure activities
- Knowledge of the health/safety requirements of & rules for the BSA outdoor programs.

This course is **not a total training program** enabling members to be an expert or even self-sufficient in any aspect of outdoor skills.



## Participant Qualifications:

### Adults:

- Registered as an Adult Leader in any unit, district, council or higher position
- Be fully trained in that position

### Youth:

- 14 years of age or 13 & comp 8<sup>th</sup> grade and registered in a Crew or Troop
- Boy Scouts: Complete Troop Leadership Training
- Venturers: Completed Crew Leadership (NYLT is recommended but not required)

### All Participants

- Be current in following online :Venturing Youth Protection, Hazardous Weather, Safe Swim Defense & Safety Afloat, and Climb on Safely
- Complete Parts A, B, C of BSA Medical Form
- Approval of Scout Executive to attend

## Course Fees

- **Individual fee** is \$150 includes all meals, lodging, activities and PH course resources library on CD
- **Crew/Troop Special:** Adult Leader and youth registering from the same Crew or Troop can attend for \$250 total (\$125 each)
